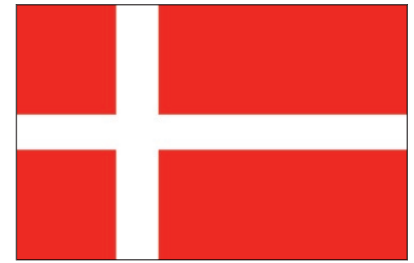

Two of the team members, Anne Sophie and Line, will finish their university studies this year and will soon be looking for jobs. Nina and Tina have full-time jobs and use all their vacations to sail.

In 2003, Nina's team took first in the Nordic Women's Match Race Championship in Roskilde, Denmark; second in the Trentino Grade 1 Match Race in Riva del Garda, Italy; sixth in the Grade W1 World Championship Match Race in Sundsvall, Sweden; and second in the Grade 1 V Criterium International Women's Match Race in Calpe, Spain. Their 2002 credits include sixth in the Grade W1 World Championship in Calpe; third in the Grade 1 Women's Antibes Cup Match Race in France; first in the Trentino event; seventh in the Grade 2 Open Berlin Match Race in Germany, and first in the Grade 4 Berlin Championship of Match Racing, also in Germany.

Nina also won the 2000 Cap Gemini Grade 1 event in Sundsvall, Sweden, as crew; and took fifth in the 1999 BoatUS Santa Maria Cup.



The team has two mascots, "Kaj" and "Andrea," which are cartoon figures in a children's television program. The team has named their two rucksacks for carrying water and spare things in after the two figures.
